Measuring Outcomes

Population health software, such as Wellcentive, can allow organizations to use a variety of measures, including those that describe processes, intermediate outcomes and long-term outcomes. The latter requires a combination of clinical data and patient-reported data.

Provider reports can be used on a combination of clinical data from different EHRs and claims information from billing systems. A registry can integrate these disparate types of data with evidence-based guidelines to generate customized reports and show how well the healthcare system is serving various segments of its patient population.

With the help of standardized reports displayed on a dashboard, practices can analyze the data over time to identify trends and spot gaps.

Analyses of the health status of population segments can show where their population health approach needs to be strengthened or modified. A dashboard can also be used for risk stratification, for identifying the prevalence of health conditions by provider or site and for evaluating.

The ability to do this kind of reporting can also help collect and submit quality data to CMS and private payers. The same data analysis that is used can be re-used for programs such as Physician Quality Reporting Initiative, Medicare and Medicaid incentive programs and health plan pay for performance programs.
